One of the most widely known was the AutoCAD program developed by Autodesk in 1982. The program was originally available only on minicomputers. Today, AutoCAD is available in various forms on desktop computers as well as mobile phones and tablets. AutoCAD LT: 1983-2007 In 1983, AutoCAD debuted as a desktop CAD program. Initially, the program could be used only on a single computer and could not be shared or transferred to other computers. The first version of AutoCAD was the only multiuser CAD product in the world. AutoCAD was developed from an idea patented by Autodesk. The drawings could be viewed on the computer screen and saved directly to a file. Since then, AutoCAD has undergone many changes, with two releases each year for five years. According to Autodesk, AutoCAD's success has been due to its intuitive interface and innovative features that made it easier to use and share drawing files. In 1995, AutoCAD was upgraded to version 9. AutoCAD users are the most satisfied of any CAD users in the world. In 1999, AutoCAD was upgraded to version 10. Ted Streshinsky Theodore "Ted" Streshinsky (; June 22, 1891 – April 23, 1971) was an American painter, sculptor, printmaker, and a leading exponent of American Realism. Biography Ted Streshinsky was born in 1891 in Cleveland, Ohio, into an immigrant Jewish family. His father, Herman Streshinsky, was a lithographer, who learned the trade from his father. Both were employed by a lithographic printer and remained there until Herman died in 1912. Ted's mother, Rachel Streshinsky, was a doctor. The couple had five children: Ralph, a well-known conductor of the Cleveland Orchestra; Mina, a writer; Isadore, a teacher; Freddie, a painter; and Barbara, a writer and daughter-in-law of Bernard Malamud. Ted attended Case Western Reserve University, and went on to study at the Philadelphia Museum School of Fine Art. He then spent a year in Paris, where he studied at the Académie Julian. Ted Streshinsky was one of the outstanding American realists of the 20th century. He was the most important exponent of the modern artist's group that flourished in the early decades of the twentieth century. His 1930 book, *American Painting*, was influential and widely used. He received numerous awards throughout his life, including the 1947 Guggenheim Fellowship, the honorary M.A. from the University of Wisconsin, the Cleveland Museum of Art's First Prize for Sculpture in 1952, and the Cleveland Museum of Art's First Prize for Painting in 1963. In 1945, he won the U.S. government's Resisting Occupation Prize. In 1958, he won the National Medal of the Arts and in 1969 the National Medal of Humanities. Among his paintings are *The Bookshelf* (1940), *America's Harvest* (1943), and *An Experiment in Oil* (1944). The
